### Winter survey strategy (Brad Cenko)

"Starting on October 15, the bulk of P48 partnership observations have transitioned to the Fast Cadence Survey of the Fastest Galactic Binaries and White Dwarf Pulsators program. This intensive monitoring of low Galactic latitude fields will continue, with a brief interruption (Oct 22 – Nov 2) for dedicated searches for Superfast Rotators, through ~ Jan 1 (exact transition date still TBD). At this time the ZTF Uniform Depth Survey (ZUDS) will commence, continuing through ~ Apr 15 (exact complete date TBD). More details about the proposed programs can be found here:".
