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News from the GROWTH marshal (Ashot Bagdasaryan)

"This week an issue with the list_program_sources.cgi script, which resulted in a timeout when loading very large programs, has been fixed".

News from working groups

AGNs and TDEs:"Our TDE Jaime (ZTF17aaazdba) remains surprising, the X-ray flux has gone up again. We continue monitoring with Swift, NICER, VLA, DCT. Earlier this week we obtained late-time DCT spectra for many sources. HST DDT observations of Melisandre (ZTF19abzrhgq) have been obtained. We are preparing for the start of ZUDS, which should be amazing for finding low-amplitude variability from weak AGN in low-mass galaxies."

Physics of supernovae and relativistic explosions: "Mattia recently finished a paper on the g-r colour of infant Type Ia SNe. The motivation is to study the distribution of radioactive material within the SN ejecta and identify the explosion channel(s) of Type Ia SNe. The main conclusions of his paper are: 1) the slope of the colour change is more informative to differentiate between models; 2) the colour distribution is consistent with double detonation models and models that require mixing of some 56-Ni with the outermost layers of the ejecta and 3) the single degenerate scenario is ruled out by this sample." **Multimessenger:** "News in real time. A neutron star-black hole GW candidate (S191205ah) was found today, December 5th. Although it barely passed the detection threshold, S191205ah was validated by human vetting. No coincident GRB detection was announced. ZTF follow-up will be attempted tonight, if the weather at Palomar improves."
