# News from working groups

Galactic and M31 Science: "The Galactic plane I-band survey is close to completion. The lower Galactic plane fields have set now, and we have collection 150+ I-band epochs. In general; we keep analyzing the new data, both PSF photometry and alerts, which continue to yield interesting objects."

**Cosmology with SNe Ia:** "Last week at the Cosmology SWG telecon we discussed plans and projects for ZTF2. We discussed follow-up proposals, e.g. early time spectroscopy to characterise Ia progenitors, NIR spectroscopy of SNe Ia to search for He I. In addition, follow-up from the discussion on SN siblings, i.e. two SNe in the same host galaxy, Jakob showed a summary of the nearby SN II-P ZTF19abqhobb which exploded in the same galaxy as ZTF18aasdted, a well-characterised SN Ia. This allows for a completely independent calibration of the SN Ia luminosity from an expanding photosphere method distance to the II-P. We discussed the possibility of following up such SN pairs in ZTF2 and will continue the discussion this week in collaboration with the SN physics SWG."

**Multimessenger:** "The follow-up of ZTF20abwysqy, the optical counterpart to short-duration GRB200826A, is on-going. Deep follow-up may allow us to tell if the burst (thus the optical afterglow discovered by ZTF) was generated by a neutron star merger or a collapsar."
