News from working groups

Galactic and M31 Science: "We have completed the Galactic Plane i-band survey. For most fields, we have reached the goal of obtaining 150 epochs. We continue to mine the ZTF data and identify and classify variable objects. The first two papers are close to completion; with one of them already <u>on ArXiv</u> this week (first author: Coughlin). Given the many interesting objects we are finding, we are currently busy writing many proposals to obtain followup resources (Keck, Gemini, LBT, LCO etc)."

AGNs and TDEs:" We are busy tracking our latest TDEs with Swift and VLA observations (eg, ZTF20abfcszi, ZTF20abjwvae) and wrapping up phase I papers on various topic: off-nuclear AGN, large AGN flares, and TDE host galaxies (see TWiki for details). The new few weeks we will be busy making our TDE/AGN pipeline compatible with the new Marshal."

Cosmology with SNe Ia: "AMPEL v0.7 is now being put into production, which among other things allows native multi-messenger/multi-stream alert processing. AMPELv0.7 can push data analysis products to different outputs, including the SkyPortal used by Fritz."

Multimessenger: "Last Saturday was a busy day, as we received two high-energy neutrino alerts. One unfortunately was too close to the sun, but we performed follow-up for the other one (IC-200926A). Sadly, we discovered no candidate counterparts."
