News from working groups

Machine Learning: "We have made some changes to the RB pipeline to reduce contamination. Only labels of 'Bogus' from the weekly GROWTH marshall feed will be added as bogus examples. We will ignore labels such as 'Stellar', 'Negative', 'Moving', 'AGN', and 'Not relevant to this'. We plan to build new RB classifiers that incorporate these changes starting next week. We are simultaneously working on implementing hyperparameter optimization, re-vetting of labeled candidates and building training data for a Galactic-plane specific classifier. We will start to look at match files, especially for help with RB in the Galactic plane."

SNe Ia / Cosmology: "We have started a deeper spectroscopic observation run in order to type SNe Ia beyond the depth of the Bright Transient SEDm program. Since no ZTF observations were taken this week, we are also trying to type some SEDM targets that have faded below the BTS threshold." Galactic/M31: "We are working on several abstracts for the AAS and continue our period search in the ZTF lightcurves. Some of us put in observing proposals. Two external collaborators were approved. Welcome to JJ Hermes and Monika Soraisam."
