The ZTF Zooniverse project:

"The ZTF Zooniverse project was featured on the <u>Zooniverse page</u> and has attracted over 200 volunteers. They have done more than 16K classifications so far on close to 7000 distinct objects. Some members of the ML team have been responding to questions posed by volunteers. It will be great if more ZTF members can answer the questions and also keep an eye on the interesting objects being marked. We already have talk boards and tags where these can be collected, but we will also create some "collections" on the Zooniverse page where objects of specific types can be collected.."

News from working groups

Supernovae and relativistic explosions: "This week, the Supernovae and Relativistic Explosions group heard updates on two papers about ready to be circulated: one on the SN IIb ZTF18aalrxas (led by Christoffer Fremling) and one on the SN Ibn ZTF18aakuewf (led by Emir Karamehmetoglu). Both of these have their early phases beautifully captured in ZTF high-cadence data."

AGNs and TDEs: "ZTFbh SWG has a new telecon time in 2019: Wednesdays at 2pm Eastern. We also have a new TDE candidate we are hoping to get a classification spectrum for, and we are continuing follow-up of our active TDE SansaStark (ZTF18abxftqm) with XMM and HST (DDT approved). We miss SEDM, and will be excited to use it again after its enhancements!"

EM/GW and **Neutrino Counterparts:** "We received a high-energy starting track (HESE) neutrino trigger from IceCube (https://gcn.gsfc.nasa.gov/gcn3/23785.gcn3). Unfortunately, the neutrino direction is only 13 degrees from the Sun, which is bad news for most follow-up observations. Hopefully we'll be more lucky for the next one."

<u>The papers corner:</u> The ZTF Science Objectives paper has finally been accepted by PASP. Thanks to everyone for their contributions to this.

March collaboration meeting in Israel:
