Real-time status of subsystems on the Twiki

There is now a section on the <u>ZTF Operations page</u> on the wiki called "Real-time status of subsystems" which has links to the various monitoring tools for the components of the ZTF pipeline. You can check if we are observing, what we are observing, if the data is flowing to IPAC, if IPAC are processing the data, and if events are flowing out through UW.

News from AMPEL

AMPEL is now using two different senders to submit candidates to the TNS: 'ZTF_AMPEL_NEW' is designed to only send candidates that are known to be new, i.e. look for these for supernovae for immediate follow-up. 'ZTF_AMPEL_COMPLETE' is more generous and will also submit for example older candidates. The complete sender will add AGNs, slowly rising objects and will allow more candidates to be submitted during periods of poor Palomar weather.

News from working groups

Supernovae and relativistic explosions: "The Supernova and Relativistic Explosions group are still busy preparing observing proposals, but also found time this week to discuss the new Astronotes service from TNS and a few instances of what looks like supernovae in the same locations but are probably just coincidences (within the same galaxy but offset). We also have a new paper from our group on the arXiv this week: 'ZTF18aalrxas: A Type IIb Supernova from a very extended low-mass progenitor', arXiv:1903.09262"

Cosmology & SNe Ia: "We are continuing our efforts to obtain spectroscopy for potential SNe Ia fainter than 18.5 mag and to further automate the selection process. Furthermore we are compiling full three-band lightcurves of the SNe found in year 1."
