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## **News from working groups**

**Supernovae and relativistic explosions:** ""We have been busy with HST proposals, with at least 4 ZTF supernova-related proposals submitted by members of our working group. We also discussed a new flash-spectroscopy object, ZTF19aanpcep."

**Solar System:** "(1) Our NEO search suffers from the unstable weather -- but we managed to discovery two new NEOs, 2019 GA (found on Apr 1) and 2019 GE (found on Apr 2). 2019 GA is a rare, Aten-type NEO. Both passed harmlessly by the Earth. (2) We are glad to see the returning of the twilight survey and are hoping to find more Interior-to-Earth NEOs."

Galactic and M31 Science: "We are continuing our search for short period white-dwarf+white-dwarf binaries, and found another one in one of the Galactic high cadence fields (period=23 minutes). We are also slowly gearing up for this years Galactic Plane observations.

EM/GW and Neutrino Counterparts: "We have received a high-energy neutrino alert on Sunday, March 31 (https://gcn.gsfc.nasa.gov/notices\_amon/15947448\_132379.amon). More computing intensive refined reconstructions revealed that the initial direction was off. The new direction (https://gcn.gsfc.nasa.gov/gcn3/24028.gcn3) was in the South and too close to the Sun to be observed by ZTF. AGILE reported a gamma-ray excess in spatial coincidence with the neutrino position

(http://www.astronomerstelegram.org/?read=12623), which was ruled out by Fermi-LAT with an upper limit 2 orders of magnitude below the claimed detection

(http://www.astronomerstelegram.org/?read=12624).
