"We have updated the downloadable photometry page, print_lc.cgi, to include the column isdiffpos so users can know which photometry points are negative. Users may need to update their scripts that use this functionality to prevent the potential adverse effects caused by having a new output on this page."

News from working groups

Machine Learning: "(1) Some of us visited UW to discuss various ML aspects of variability, with an emphasis on stellar variability. Some golden datasets will be created on which various techniques can be tried. Matthew and Eric will circulate minutes. (2) Dima has labeled several thousand real and bogus objects for real-bogus classification. This set can be used with RF and DL methods. (3) We are taking a short break from Zooniverse as we analyze the data collected so far. We plan to move to more challenging areas like fainter transients, variables and transients in higher density areas."

with SEDM, we have started submitting targets to ePESSTO. Furthermore we have started looking into the peak brightnesses of supernovae in the ZTF sample so far in order to measure their luminosity functions more precisely and understand selection effects better."
