# **Palomar Adaptive Optics Test Plan**

## Purpose

We outline here the procedure to co-focus the LOWFS, HOWFS and PHARO for night time operation. All work is done with the white light.

### Test procedure

- 1. Setup
  - 1.1. Go to NGS mode
  - 1.2. Move lgs\_x to the LGS position (99000)
  - 1.3. LOWFS
    - 1.3.1. load zero offsets
    - 1.3.2. Set rate to 500Hz
  - 1.4. HOWFS
    - 1.4.1. load zero offsets
    - 1.4.2. Set rate to 100 Hz
    - 1.4.3. Load pixel\_gains\_lse\_sep03
    - 1.4.4. Move image\_x 2.75" (left)
    - 1.4.5. Move image\_y .25" (down)
    - 1.4.6. Take HOWFS background
  - 1.5. Acquire white light in HOWFS with power at 35, Lock TT and DM loops
  - 1.6. Adjust wfs z so that there is no focus in the HOWFS
    - 1.6.1. With both loops locked, adjust the wfs\_z so that the desired motion (shown in Mitch's WFS plots, DM Positions) is close to zero
  - 1.7. Take and load a white light flat map
    - 1.7.1. *IDL>* ao\_make\_dm\_flat\_map,'filename'
    - 1.7.2. With just the TT loop locked, verify that there is no focus in the flatmap by looking at the DM positions data (in Mitch's WFS plots). If there is focus, go back to step 1.6
  - 1.8. It is more important to get the focus zero in the flatmap than in the locked DM loop.
- 2. Co-focus LOWFS and HOWFS to white light
  - 2.1. Lock in dual mode
    - 2.1.1. Go to DNGS mode
    - 2.1.2. Acquire LOWFS using acqview
      - 2.1.2.1. Click ACQ
      - 2.1.2.2. Click on spot when it appears
      - 2.1.2.3. Click "Send LOWFS"
    - 2.1.3. Take LOWFS background
    - 2.1.4. From Igstools, click "zero cent"
    - 2.1.5. Lock TT on LOWFS

- 2.1.6. If HO residuals are close, lock DM on HOWFS
- 2.2. zero LOWFS focus using manual z-stage
  - 2.2.1. start lgsfoc, set the LOWFS zero point to zero, set gain to 0.5
  - 2.2.2. Adjust the measured LOWFS focus using the z-stage micrometer
    - 2.2.2.1. Unlock the stage using a 3/32 allen key
    - 2.2.2.2. + means move toward focus, move half as much as measured
  - 2.2.3. Lock stage and note new position
- 3. Re-focus acquisition camera
  - 3.1. In acqview, click ACQ
  - 3.2. Set the video camera to integrate at 1Hz, saving 1 frame a second
  - 3.3. Set white light power to 20
  - 3.4. Check to make sure the peak counts are less then ~100. If necessary decrease the white light power
  - 3.5. Shut off white light and take and save a background using ao\_plot\_vid\_image in IDL, call it acg\_wl\_bkgd
  - 3.6. Turn the white light back on and focus using
    - 3.6.1. ao\_focus\_loop, 'current acq\_z position' -600, 300, 5, 'acq' ,'acq\_wl\_', sky='acq\_wl\_bkgd', time\_to\_avg=2
    - 3.6.2. move acq\_z to optimal position and note new position
- 4. Save new AO config files
  - 4.1. Save as LGS\_date
  - 4.2. Make sure:
    - 4.2.1. acquisition camera is off
    - 4.2.2. lowfs\_y is at 0
  - 4.3. Copy LGS date to LGS
  - 4.4. NGS config
    - 4.4.1. Shift Igs x to the NGS position
    - 4.4.2. Go to NGS mode
    - 4.4.3. Lock on white light and adjust wfs\_z focus to get zero desired motion
    - 4.4.4. Save as NGS\_date
  - 4.5. Copy NGS\_date to DEFAULT
- 5. Sweet spot
  - 5.1. Lock the loops on the NGS position
  - 5.2. Move lgs x to the LGS position
  - 5.3. Take note of the spot location in the acquisition camera
  - 5.4. Send the LOWFS to the spot
  - 5.5. Take a LOWFS background
  - 5.6. Use the zero\_cent button to reduce the residuals
  - 5.7. Take note of the LOWFS X and Y positions
- 6. PHARO alignment
  - 6.1. re-focus PHARO
    - 6.1.1. lock HOWFS on zero offsets
    - 6.1.2. focus PHARO to maximize Strehl/minimize FWHM.
  - 6.2. re-tune centroid offsets in HOWFS
